**FIRST WORD IN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH ACTS 7:54-8-1**

<sup>54</sup>When they heard these things, they became enraged and ground their teeth at Stephen. <sup>55</sup>But filled with the Holy Spirit, he gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God and Jesus standing at the right hand of God. <sup>56</sup>Look, he said, "I see the heavens opened and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God!" <sup>57</sup>But they covered their ears, and with a loud shout all rushed together against him. <sup>58</sup>Then they dragged him out of the city and began to stone him; and the witnesses laid their coats at the feet of a young man named Saul. <sup>59</sup>While they were stoning Stephen, he prayed, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." <sup>60</sup>Then he knelt down and cried out in a loud voice, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them." When he had said this, he died.

<sup>1</sup>And Saul approved of their killing him. That day a severe persecution began against the church in Jerusalem, and all except the apostles were scattered throughout the countryside of Judea and Samaria.

Also lead us to forgive, as we have been forgiven, following in the footsteps of St. Stephen, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

<sup>43</sup>He replied, "Truly I tell you, today you will be with me in Paradise."

### **"Jesus, in Thy Dying Woes" vss. 4-6**

Jesus, pitying the sighs of the thief, who near thee dies,  
promising him paradise: hear us, holy Jesus.

May we in our guilt and shame still thy love and mercy claim,

## **SECOND WORD IN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH ACTS 2:29-38**

<sup>29</sup>Fellow Israelites, I may say to you confidently of our ancestor David that he both died and was buried, and his tomb is with us to this day. <sup>30</sup>Since he was a prophet, he knew that God had sworn with an oath to him that he would put one of his descendants on his throne. <sup>31</sup>Foreseeing this, David spoke of the resurrection of the Messiah, saying, 'He was not abandoned to Hades, nor did his flesh experience corruption.' <sup>32</sup>This Jesus God raised up, and of that all of us are witnesses. <sup>33</sup>Being therefore exalted at the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, he has poured out this that you both see and hear. <sup>34</sup>For David did not ascend into the heavens, but he himself says, 'The Lord said to my Lord, "Sit at my right hand, <sup>35</sup>until I make your enemies your footstool.'" ' <sup>36</sup>Therefore let the entire house of Israel know with certainty that God has made him both Lord and Messiah, this Jesus whom you crucified." <sup>37</sup>Now when they heard this, they were cut to the heart and said to Peter and to the other apostles, "Brothers, what should we do?" <sup>38</sup>Peter said to them, "Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ so that your sins may be forgiven; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

<sup>26</sup>When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing beside her, he said to his mother, "Woman, here is your son." <sup>27</sup>Then he said to the disciple, "Here is your mother." And from that hour the disciple took her into his own home.

Jesus, loving to the end her whose heart thy sorrows rend,  
and thy dearest human friend: hear us, holy Jesus.

May we in thy sorrows share, for thy sake all peril dare,  
and enjoy thy tender care: hear us, holy Jesus.

May we all thy loved ones be, all one holy family,  
loving for the love of thee: hear us, holy Jesus.

### **THIRD WORD IN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH: 1 JOHN 4:16B-21**

<sup>16</sup>So we have known and believe the love that God has for us. God is love, and those who abide in love abide in God, and God abides in them. <sup>17</sup>Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness on the day of judgment, because as he is, so are we in this world. <sup>18</sup>There is no fear in love, but perfect love casts out fear; for fear has to do with punishment, and whoever fears has not reached perfection in love. <sup>19</sup>We love because he first loved us. <sup>20</sup>Those who say, "I love God," and hate their brothers or sisters, are liars; for those who do not love a brother or sister whom they have seen, cannot love God whom they have not seen. <sup>21</sup>The commandment we have from him is this: those who love God must love their brothers and sisters also.

**Prayer:** O Blessed Savior, who in your hours of greatest suffering expressed compassion for your mother and made arrangements for her care, grant that we who seek to follow your example may show concern for the needs of others, reaching out to provide for those who suffer in our human family. Lead us also to love one another as Jesus first loved us; living out the truth that they will know we are Christians by love, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

### **FOURTH WORD: MATTHEW 27:46**

<sup>46</sup>And about three o'clock Jesus cried with a loud voice, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" that is, "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"

### **“Jesus, in Thy Dying Woes” vss. 10-12**

Jesus, whelmed in fears unknown, with our evil left alone,  
while no light from heav’n is shown: hear us, holy Jesus.

When we seem in vain to pray and our hope seems far away,  
in the darkness be our stay: hear us, holy Jesus.

Though no Father seem to hear, though no light our spirits cheer,

### **FOURTH WORD IN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH: 2 CORINTHIANS 12:2-10**

<sup>2</sup>I know a person in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven — whether in the body or out of the body I do not know; God knows. <sup>3</sup>And I know that such a person — whether in the body or out of the body I do not know; God knows — <sup>4</sup>was caught up into Paradise and heard things that are not to be told, that no mortal is permitted to repeat. <sup>5</sup>On behalf of such a one I will boast, but on my own behalf I will not boast, except of my weaknesses. <sup>6</sup>But if I wish to boast, I will not be a fool, for I will be speaking the truth. But I refrain from it, so that no one may think better of me than what is seen in me or heard from me, <sup>7</sup>even considering the exceptional character of the revelations. Therefore, to keep me from being too elated, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to torment me, to keep me from being too elated. <sup>8</sup>Three times I appealed to the Lord about this, that it would leave me, <sup>9</sup>but he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness." So, I will boast all the more gladly of my weaknesses, so that the power of Christ may dwell in me. <sup>10</sup>Therefore I am content with weaknesses, insults, hardships, persecutions, and calamities for the sake of Christ; for whenever I am weak, then I am strong.

**Thanks be to God!**

**Prayer:** Almighty God, who forsook your Son upon the cross showing the world your judgement upon human sin and guilt, grant us, upon hearing his cry, the grace to know and believe that we will never be forsaken, that he is present with us even to the end of the age. In times of trial and temptation, lead us also to draw upon the comfort and consolation of Scripture as Jesus did more than once on Good Friday, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

## **FIFTH WORD: JOHN 19:28**

<sup>28</sup>After this, when Jesus knew that all was now finished, he said (in order to fulfill the scripture), "I am thirsty."

### **"Jesus, in Thy Dying Woes" vss. 13-15**

Jesus, in thy thirst and pain, while thy wounds thy lifeblood drain,  
thirsting more our love to gain: hear us, holy Jesus.

Thirst for us in mercy still; all thy holy work fulfill;  
satisfy thy loving will: hear us, holy Jesus.

May we thirst thy love to know; lead us in our sin and woe  
where the healing waters flow: hear us, holy Jesus.

## **FIFTH WORD IN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH: MATTHEW 5:1-12**

<sup>1</sup>When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him. <sup>2</sup>Then he began to speak, and taught them, saying:

## SIXTH WORD IN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH: HEBREWS 10:1-18

<sup>1</sup>Since the law has only a shadow of the good things to come and not the true form of these realities, it can never, by the same sacrifices that are continually offered year after year, make perfect those who approach. <sup>2</sup>Otherwise, would they not have ceased being offered, since the worshipers, cleansed once for all, would no longer have any consciousness of sin? <sup>3</sup>But in these sacrifices there is a

reminder of sin year after year. <sup>4</sup>For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins. <sup>5</sup>Consequently, when Christ came into the world, he said, "Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body you have prepared for me; <sup>6</sup>in burnt offerings and sin offerings you have taken no pleasure.

<sup>7</sup>Then I said, 'See, God, I have come to do your will, O God' (in the scroll of the book it is written of me)."

<sup>8</sup>When he said above, "You have neither desired nor taken pleasure in sacrifices and offerings and burnt offerings and sin offerings" (these are offered according to the law), <sup>9</sup>then he added, "See, I have come to do your will." He abolishes the first in order to establish the second. <sup>10</sup>And it is by God's will that we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

<sup>11</sup>And every priest stands day after day at his service, offering again and again the same sacrifices that can never take away sins. <sup>12</sup>But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, "he sat down at the right hand of God," <sup>13</sup>and since then has been waiting "until his enemies would be made a footstool for his feet." <sup>14</sup>For by a single offering he has perfected for all time those who are sanctified. <sup>15</sup>And the Holy Spirit also testifies to us, for after saying, <sup>16</sup>"This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord: I will put my laws in their hearts, and I will write them on their minds," <sup>17</sup>he also adds, "I will remember their sins and their lawless deeds no more." <sup>18</sup>Where there is forgiveness of these, there is no longer any offering for sin.

The Word of the Lord,

**Thanks be to God!**

**Prayer:** O Lord Jesus Christ, who finished the work that you were sent to do, enable us by your Holy Spirit to be faithful to your call. Grant us strength to bear our crosses and endure our sufferings, even unto death. Trusting and never forgetting that you finished our salvation on the cross once and for all, enable us to live and love so faithfully that we also become good news to the world, joining your witness, O Christ, in whose name we pray. Amen.

### **SEVENTH WORD: LUKE 23:46**

<sup>46</sup>Then Jesus, crying with a loud voice, said, "Father, into your hands I commend my spirit." Having said this, he breathed his last.

#### **"Jesus, in Thy Dying Woes" vss. 19-21**

Jesus, all thy labor vast, all thy woe and conflict past;  
yielding up thy soul at last: hear us, holy Jesus.

When the death shades round us low'r, guard us from the tempter's pow'r,  
keep us in that trial hour: hear us, holy Jesus.

May thy life and death supply grace to live and grace to die,  
grace to reach the home on high: hear us, holy Jesus.

### **SEVENTH WORD IN THE LIFE OF THE CHURCH: PHILIPPIANS 3:4B-14**

<sup>4</sup>even though I, too, have reason for confidence in the flesh. If anyone else has reason to be confident in the flesh, I have more: <sup>5</sup>circumcised on the eighth day, a member of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew born of Hebrews; as to the law, a Pharisee; <sup>6</sup>as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to righteousness under the law, blameless. <sup>7</sup>Yet whatever gains I had, these I have come to regard as loss because of Christ. <sup>8</sup>More than that, I regard everything as loss because of the surpassing value of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things, and I regard them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ <sup>9</sup>and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but one that comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God based on faith. <sup>10</sup>I want to know Christ and the power of his resurrection and the sharing of his sufferings by becoming like him in his death, <sup>11</sup>if somehow I may attain the resurrection from the dead.

<sup>12</sup>Not that I have already obtained this or have already reached the goal; but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. <sup>13</sup>Beloved, I do not consider that I have made it my own but this one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, <sup>14</sup>I press on toward the goal for the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus.

**Thanks be to God!**

**Prayer:** Father, into whose hands your Son Jesus Christ commended his spirit, grant that we too, following his example and leaning forward toward the promised moment when all will be made new by your grace, may in all life and at the moment of our death entrust our lives into your faithful hands of love, through Christ our Lord. Amen.

P: Let us pray, brothers and sisters, for the holy church throughout the world.

*Silent prayer.*

P: Almighty and eternal God, you have shown your glory to all nations in Jesus Christ. By your Holy Spirit guide the church and gather it throughout the world. Help it to persevere in faith, proclaim your name, and bring the good news of salvation in Christ to all people. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

P: Let us pray for our sisters and brothers who share our faith in Jesus Christ.

*Silent prayer.*

P: Almighty and eternal God, you give your church unity. Look with favor on all who follow Jesus your Son. Make all the baptized one in the fullness of faith, and keep us united in the fellowship of love. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

**A: Amen.**

P: Let us pray for the Jewish people, the first to hear the word of God.

*Silent prayer.*

P: Almighty and eternal God, long ago you gave your promise to Abraham and your teaching to Moses. Hear our prayers that the people you called and elected as your own may receive the fulfillment of the covenant's promises. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

**A: Amen.**

Let us pray for those who do not share our faith in Jesus Christ.

*Silent prayer.*

Almighty and eternal God, gather into your embrace all those who call out to you under different names. Bring an end to inter-religious strife, and make us more

faithful witnesses of the love made known to us in your Son. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

**A: Amen.**

P: Let us pray for those who do not believe in God.

*Silent prayer.*

P: Almighty and eternal God, you created humanity so that all may long to know you and find peace in you. Grant that all may recognize the signs of your love and grace in the world and in the lives of Christians, and gladly acknowledge you as the one true God. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

**A: Amen.**

P: Let us pray for God's creation.

*Silent prayer.*

P: Almighty and eternal God, you are the creator of a magnificent universe. Hold all the worlds in the arms of your care and bring all things to fulfillment in you. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

**A: Amen.**

P: Let us pray for those who serve in public office.

*Silent prayer.*

P: Almighty and eternal God, you are the champion of the poor and oppressed. In your goodness, give wisdom to those in authority, so that all people may enjoy justice, peace, freedom, and a share in the goodness of your creation. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

**A: Amen.**

Let us pray for those in need.

*Silent prayer.*

Almighty and eternal God, you give strength to the weary and new courage to those who have lost heart. Heal the sick, comfort the dying, give safety to travelers, free those unjustly deprived of liberty, and deliver your world from falsehood, hunger, and disease. Hear the prayers of all who call on you in any trouble, that they may have the joy of receiving your help in their need. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

**Amen.**

P: Finally, let us pray for all those things for which our Lord would have us ask.

### **LORD'S PRAYER**

P: Lord, remember us in your kingdom and teach us to pray.

**A: Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done, on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.**

### **PSALM 22**

P: My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why so far from saving me, so far from the words of my groaning?

**A: My God, I cry out by day, but you do not answer; by night, but I find no rest.**

P: Yet you are the Holy One, enthroned on the praises of Israel.

**A: Our ancestors put their trust in you, they trusted, and you rescued them.**

P: They cried out to you and were delivered; they trusted in you and were not put to shame.

**A: But as for me, I am a worm and not human, scorned by all and despised by the people.**

P: All who see me laugh me to scorn; they curl their lips; they shake their heads.

**A: "Trust in the LORD; let the LORD deliver; let God rescue him if God so delights in him."**

P: Yet you are the one who drew me forth from the womb, and kept me safe on my mother's breast.

**A: I have been entrusted to you ever since I was born; you were my God when I was still in my mother's womb.**

P: Be not far from me, for trouble is near, and there is no one to help.

**A: Many young bulls encircle me; strong bulls of Bashan surround me.**

P: They open wide their jaws at me, like a slashing and roaring lion.

**A: I am poured out like water; all my bones are out of joint; my heart within my breast is melting wax.**

P: My strength is dried up like a potsherd; my tongue sticks to the roof of my mouth; and you have laid me in the dust of death.

**A: Packs of dogs close me in, a band of evildoers circles round me; they pierce my hands and my feet.**

P: I can count all my bones while they stare at me and gloat.

**A: They divide my garments among them; for my clothing, they cast lots.**

P: But you, O LORD, be not far away; O my help, hasten to my aid.

**A: Deliver me from the sword, my life from the power of the dog.**

P: Save me from the lion's mouth! From the horns of wild bulls you have rescued me.

**A: I will declare your name to my people; in the midst of the assembly I will praise you.**

P: You who fear the LORD, give praise! All you of Jacob's line, give glory. Stand in awe of the LORD, all you off-spring of Israel.

**A: For the LORD does not despise nor abhor the poor in their poverty; neither is the LORD's face hidden from them; but when they cry out, the LORD hears them.**

P: From you comes my praise in the great assembly; I will perform my vows in the sight of those who fear the LORD.

**A: The poor shall eat and be satisfied, Let those who seek the LORD give praise! May your hearts live forever!**

P: All the ends of the earth shall remember and turn to the LORD; all the families of nations shall bow before God.

**A: For dominion belongs to the LORD, who rules over the nations.**

P: Indeed, all who sleep in the earth shall bow down in worship; all who go down to the dust, though they be dead, shall kneel before the LORD.

**A: Their descendants shall serve the LORD, whom they shall proclaim to generations to come.**

P: They shall proclaim God's deliverance to a people yet unborn, saying to them, "The LORD has acted!"
